Adhesive Residue

Description

Duct tape, masking tape or even protective coatings have been applied to carpet and later removed leaving a sticky, soil attracting residue.

Tools Required

- Hot water extraction equipment
- Gum Getter or spotting spatula
- White cotton colorfast towels

Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint Gel Break
- Bridgepoint Solvent Clean
- Bridgepoint Encapuguard Green (optional)

Procedures

- 1. Apply Gel Break to affected area.
- 2. Agitate with **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula.
- 3. Allow 3 to 5 minutes dwell time.
- 4. Extract with hot water.
- 5. If residue remains, apply Solvent Clean.
- 6. Agitate with **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula, wipe with clean white cotton towel
- 7. Extract with hot water.
- 8. Apply **Encapuguard Green** diluted according to label directions. This will prevent wicking / resoiling.
- 9. For large areas the application may vary but the basic keys remain solvents, agitation and heat.
