

# Spotting Procedures

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## degree of difficulty

1 (easiest – complete removal likely)

5 (extremely difficult to remove- limited expectation of success).



## Chocolate

### Description

This can include chocolate candy as well as beverages like cocoa and chocolate milk.

### Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula
- White cotton towels
- **Flash Spotter** or **Spot Claw** by Water Claw
- Sprayer

### Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint **Avenge Neutral Spotter**
- Bridgepoint **StainZONE**
- Bridgepoint **Encapuguard Green**

### Procedures

1. For beverage spills flush using **Flash Spotter** or **Spot Claw**. Introduce water around the outside of the stain while applying vacuum through the spotting tool. Continue until extracted water runs clear. Continue vacuum to get carpet as dry as possible.
2. Apply **Avenge Neutral Spotter** generously to the affected area.
3. Agitate with spotting spatula. Allow 3 to 5 minutes dwell time.
4. Extract with water.
5. If color remains, Apply **StainZONE**. Staining will fade gradually as the **StainZONE** dries. You can leave it damp. There is no need for a final rinse.
6. For beverage spills, apply a solution of **Encapuguard Green** to prevent wicking.

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
