

Spotting Procedures

Glue

Description

Glue for school and craft work, wood glue, Elmer's Glue-All and similar products.

Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula
- White cotton towels
- Wall paper steamer (optional)

Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint **Citrus Solv**
- Bridgepoint **Avenge Neutral Spotter**

Procedures

1. Apply **Citrus Solv** to affected area.
2. Agitate with **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula to break up deposit.
3. Cover spill with hot, wet white towel. The combination of **Citrus Solv** and wet heat will soften the glue after a few minutes. You may wish to accelerate the process by using a wall paper steamer to provide wet heat or using steam from a steam iron held a few inches above the spot.
4. Flush with hot water.
5. Apply **Avenge Neutral Spotter**.
6. Agitate **Gum Getter** or spatula to open and separate fibers
7. Allow 2 to 3 minutes of dwell time
8. Extract with hot water.
