Glue

Description

Glue for school and craft work, wood glue, Elmer's Glue-All and similar products.

Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- Gum Getter or spotting spatula
- White cotton towels
- Wall paper steamer (optional)

Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint Citrus Solv
- Bridgepoint Avenge Neutral Spotter

Procedures

- 1. Apply Citrus Solv to affected area.
- 2. Agitate with **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula to break up deposit.
- 3. Cover spill with hot, wet white towel. The combination of **Citrus Solv** and wet heat will soften the glue after a few minutes. You may wish to accelerate the process by using a wall paper steamer to provide wet heat or using steam from a steam iron held a few inches above the spot.
- 4. Flush with hot water.
- 5. Apply Avenge Neutral Spotter.
- 6. Agitate Gum Getter or spatula to open and separate fibers
- 7. Allow 2 to 3 minutes of dwell time
- 8. Extract with hot water.
