Potpourri

Description

Not the category on Jeopardy. Potpourri is a fragrant mixture of dried plant material along with herbs, spices and possibly wood shavings. Perfumed oils and dyes are commonly added to the mixture. These oils and dyes may stain light colored fibers or the oils may attract soil in the air or on the bottom of shoes.

Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- Handi Groom or spotting spatula
- Tamping brush
- White cotton towel

Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint Solvent Clean
- Bridgepoint StainZONE

Procedures

- 1. Vacuum or scrape up as much of the dried material as possible. Use spotting spatula, edge of **Handi Groom**, or a spoon.
- 2. Apply **Solvent Clean** directly to the stain or apply first to white towel and then dab onto affected area.
- 3. Allow 2 or 3 minutes of dwell time.
- 4. Use absorbent white towel dampened with **Solvent Clean** to gently wipe fibers from all directions. Change to clean area of towel as necessary.
- 5. If color remains, apply **StainZONE**. Work into stain using **Handi Groom** or spotting spatula.
- 6. Allow dwell time. Stain will slow fade as the **StainZONE** works.
