

Spotting Procedures



degree of difficulty

1 (easiest – complete removal likely)
5 (extremely difficult to remove- limited expectation of success).

Description

However you spell it, the kids love it on fries, hot dogs, burgers and so forth. Sooner or later, some ends up on the carpet.

Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- **Handi Groom**, tamping brush or spotting spatula
- White cotton towels

Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint **Avenge Neutral Spotter**
- Bridgepoint **RedZONE**

Procedures

1. Remove as much excess staining material as possible by blotting or scraping using a **Handi-Groom**, spotting spatula or edge of a spoon.
2. Apply **Avenge Neutral Spotter** to the affected area.
3. Work into stain with tamping brush and towels or spotting spatula.
4. Allow 3 to 5 minutes dwell time.
5. Extract thoroughly with hot water. Make several vacuum only passes to leave carpet as dry as possible.
6. If discoloration persists, apply **RedZONE**, work into stain and allow 5 minutes dwell time. Extract.
7. If necessary, apply additional **RedZONE**, apply heat using steam iron or wallpaper steamer. Check progress every 30 seconds. Stain should be gone in 2 to 3 minutes. Rinse and extract.
