

# Spotting Procedures



## degree of difficulty

1 (easiest – complete removal likely)  
5 (extremely difficult to remove- limited expectation of success).



## Pizza Sauce

### Description

Pizza can be great to eat while watching a big game on TV. Plenty of rich red tomato sauce spice and cheese but those drips of can really stain.

### Tools Required

- Extraction equipment
- **Handi Groom** or spotting spatula
- Tamping brush
- White cotton towel

### Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint **Protein Spotter**
- Bridgepoint **StainZONE**

### Procedures

1. Scrape up any sauce that can be removed without spotting agents. Use cotton towels along with spatula, edge of Handi Groom, or a spoon.
2. Apply **Protein Spotter** working it into the stain with Gum Getter, spotting spatula or tamp into white towel.
3. Allow 5 or more minutes of dwell time
4. Flush, rinse and extract using **Flash Spotter** or **Spot Lifter**. Get fibers as dry as possible.
5. If color remains, apply **StainZONE**. Work into stain using **Handi Groom** or spotting spatula.
6. Allow dwell time. Stain will slow fade as the **StainZONE** works.
