

# Spotting Procedures



## degree of difficulty

1 (easiest – complete removal likely)

5 (extremely difficult to remove- limited expectation of success).



## Window Cleaner - Windex®

### Description

Overspray from customer cleaning windows, or bottle or bucket knocked over and spilled leaves a bluish hue to the light colored carpet.

### Tools Required

- Hot water extraction capability
- **Gum Getter** or spotting spatula
- Steam iron or wallpaper steamer
- White cotton colorfast towels
- Trigger Sprayer

### Chemicals Required

- Bridgepoint **RedZONE**
- Bridgepoint **Avenge**

### Procedures

1. If possible, thoroughly extract area
2. Apply **Avenge** straight evenly across the stain with a flip top applicator. For large contaminated areas, use trigger sprayer.
3. Agitate gently with spatula to assure penetration.
4. Extract area thoroughly. If extractor is not available, blot area with water.
5. If discoloration remains, apply **RedZONE** straight evenly across the stain with a flip top applicator. For large contaminated areas, use trigger sprayer.
6. If necessary, consider application of heat using steam iron or wallpaper steamer.
7. Allow area to dry completely.

Note: The stain will fade away as it reacts with the **StainZONE**. Reaction time and results will vary.
